"It was a pitching dual," A's coach, Rod Lampe said. "It was great pitching by both ends (Matt Raile for the A's and Trent Raile for

the Sox.)"

The A's scoring took place when two runners (Drew Zwegardt and Garrett Zwegardt) reached base on walks in the first inning and Trent Kinen connected on a double to send both men across the plate, giving Kinen two runs batted in (RBI's). Later Kinen reached home plate on an error to put the A's up 3-0. That was the end of their scoring for the game.

Coach Lampe said Kinen's hit "was a nice drive to left center."

In the second inning, the Sox run came when Freddy Pacheco reached base on a walk. He moved around the bases on steals and came home to score on an error.

The second Sox run started with a walk to Jesse Pacheco and ended when Darris Keller hit a line-drive single to send him home.
