The attack was planned for a Sunday morning as it would be the time to most likely catch the Americans off guard. Of the 2,390 service men and 49 civilians who died in the attack, nearly half were members of the U.S.S. Arizona's

Aboard the battleship that still lies in 40 feet of water, 1,177 either remain entombed or were buried. The ship exploded when a bomb reached the forward magazine and set off the explosives stored there.

These numbers are well documented, but what most may not know is that there were many


