

## **Diving** safety tips

Diving is one of the most hazardous water activities. Most diving-related injuries occur in pools with five feet of water or less. The Kansas SAFE KIDS Coalition urges parents to take the following precautions to prevent diving-related injuries

• Do not let your children dive into water unless an adult is present and knows that the depth of the water if greater than five

• Never allow your children to dive into above-ground pools.

• Teach your children to dive with their hands in front of their face and to swim toward the surface immediately upon entering the water to avoid hitting the bottom of sides of the

• Teach them to dive only from the end of the diving board; never let them dive from rooftops, balconies. ledges or fences.

• Teach them to keep their dives simple.

 Make sure your diving board is in good condition before allowing your child to use it.

• Do not permit children to run and dive.


