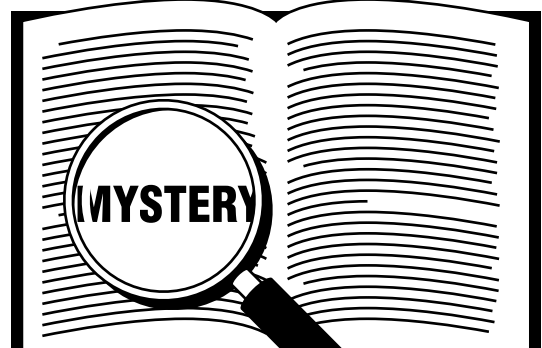

Freshmen, sophomores compete at Atwood

Norton Community High School boys and girls track athletes compete in the Freshman-Sophomore Track Meet on Monday at Atwood.

Team scores were not kept but Norton athletes set ten personal records.

In the boys division, sophomore Andrew Ables placed second in the shot put with a personal best heave of 36'7". He also threw the javelin a personal best distance of 102'11" but did not place and threw the discus 88'10" but did not place. Ables also ran the 100 meter dash where he was timed in 12.24 but did not place.

Freshman Corey Rutherford placed fourth in the javelin with a throw of 114'8" and sixth in the discus with a throw of 98'11". He also heaved the shot a personal best 28'10" but did not place and ran the 200 meter dash in a personal record time of 27.95 and did not place.

"Our throwers did a great job for us," said Coach Bruce Graber. "Dan Cummings didn't place but set personal records in three of four events."

Cummings, who is a sophomore, ran the 200 meters in a personal best time of 29.18, the 400 meter dash in a personal best time of 68.73, the 100 meter dash in 14.59 and long jumped a personal best 13'11".

Freshman Jared Bebb also competed in four events. He ran the 100 meter dash in 13.8, the 200 meter dash in 30.73, the 400 meter dash in 61.73 and long jumped a personal best distance of 15'3 3/4".

In the girls division, freshman Laura Delimont placed fifth in both the javelin and discus. She threw the javelin a personal best distance of 72'8" and the discus 81'9". She also competed in the shot put event where she heaved the shot 26'8" but did not place.

Freshman Brianne Nelson competed in four events but did not place. She set a personal record in the long jump with a leap of 12'6 1/2". Her times in three running events were: 14.89, 100 meter dash; 31.4, 200 meter dash; 73.86, 400 meter dash.
