

# Logan track teams have been competing well

The Logan track and field team has been preparing for the Regional Track Meet at each meet in which they have participated. Recently, the Trojans have competed in the Eastern Heights Invitational, the Kaser Relays, the Beloit Relays, the Logan Invitational, and the Ransom Invitational.

**Eastern Heights Invitational**  
The Logan boys track team jumped out to a lead after the field events and held on to win the Eastern Heights Invitational on April 20 in Logan. They defeated the second place Lakeside team by five points, 98 to 93.

The Trojans had two people place in each field event: shot put — Tyson Triplett, first, 45'11"; and Tim McElroy, third, 42'0.5"; discus — Triplett, first, 140'1", and Zack Sammons, second, 124'1.5"; javelin — Triplett, first, 163'2", and Kyle McClurg, third, 136'10"; pole vault — Kyle Brobst, third, 8'6", and Kevin Burge, fourth, 6'; long jump — McClurg, fourth, 18'2", and Troy Babcock, fifth, 18'1"; triple jump — Babcock, third, 39'2.75"; and Kevin Pinkerton, fifth, 37'6.5"; and high jump — Babcock, fourth, 5'6", and Jake McCue, fifth, 5'6".

In the running events, the 4 x 800m relay team of Brobst, Pinkerton, Kevin Burge, and Tanner Pabst came in third at 10:21.57; Kevin Burge took fifth in the 1600m run at 6:02.81; Kyle Burge took fourth in the 400m dash at 58.78; Pinkerton took fourth in the 800m run at 2:22.0; and the 4 x 400m relay team of Pinkerton, Pabst, McCue and McClurg placed fifth at 4:12.84.

The Trojan girls ended fourth behind non-league foes Lakeside, Victoria and Golden Plains.

In the field events, Val Jackson placed third in the discus at 89'11.5"; Darci Goddard came in second in the pole vault with 4'9" and sixth in the high jump at 4'4"; and in the javelin, Jenny Noel placed second with 98'6", Kaitlyn Noone fifth at 80'10", and Megan Brumbaugh sixth at 79'0".

The Lady Trojans earned several points in the running events, including: 4 x 800m relay team of Bethany Clements, Lisa Kiser, Jackson and Lane Webb placed first at 11:17.68; Clements took first in the 1600m run at 5:58; Webb took first in the 800m run at 2:37.65; and the 4 x 400m relay team of Brumbaugh, Clements, Jackson and Webb placed second in 4:37.4.

**Kaser Relays**  
The Trojan track team competed well at the Kaser Relays, held in Osborne on a wet and breezy April 23.

The Lady Trojans placed fifth out of 19 teams, while the guys placed eighth.

Scoring for the girls were: Webb — 800m run, first, 2:30.11; 400m dash, fourth, 1:03.08; Jackson — 400m dash, second, 1:06.45; discus, sixth, 88'; Clements — 800m run, third, 2:33.93; Brumbaugh, Noel, Goddard and Anne Hartman — 4 x 100m relay, fifth, 56.12; Harman, Clements, Jackson and Webb — 4 x 400m relay, 4:27.06; and Clements, Melanie Berg,

Jackson and Webb — 4 x 800m relay, 10:45.78.

Scoring for the boys were: Triplett — discus, first, 139'2.5"; javelin, second, 147'11"; and shot put, third, 44'10"; Zack Sammons — discus, fourth, 131'3"; Brobst, McClurg, Kyle Burge and McCue — 4 x 100m relay, 49.65; and Brobst, McClurg, Kyle Burge and Pabst, 4 x 400m relay, 3:59.31.

**Beloit Relays**  
The Logan track teams competed in the 1-2A division at the 64th annual Beloit Relays on April 30. Although the morning was a bit damp, the day turned out to be fairly nice for the meet. The Trojan men placed 14th out of 19 teams, while the Lady Trojans came in 12th.

Scoring for the Logan ladies were: Webb — 800m run, first, 2:31.06; 400m dash, fourth, 1:03.57; Brumbaugh, Noel, Goddard and Hartman — 4 x 100m relay, sixth, 56.28; and Hartman, Berg, Jackson and Webb — 4 x 800m relay, sixth, 11:10.15.

For the Trojan men, placing were: Triplett — discus, first, 142'5"; shot put, second, 47'2"; and javelin, fifth, 149'2".

**Logan Invitational**  
The Trojan track team competed well at their own Logan Invitational on May 4. The teams participating included Brewster, Cheylin, Eastern Heights, Golden Plains, Jennings, Kensington, Logan, Natoma, Northern Valley, Ransom, Sharon Springs, Triplains and Victoria.

The Ransom girls won their side of the meet, scoring 100 points. Logan and Golden Plains tied for second with 77 points apiece.

The Northern Valley boys won their side with a total score of 76 points. Victoria came in second with 74, followed closely by Logan with 73.

**Ransom Invitational**  
The Logan track team competed at the Ransom Invitational for the last time on May 7 in Ness City. The Lady Trojans came in 7th out of 21 teams, while the men placed 6th.

"Although we had fewer people place at this meet, many of the athletes set new personal records here," said Coach Linda Nighswonger. "It was good to compete against some of the teams that we will see at the Regional meet to see where we are and where we still need to go."

The Trojan men who placed were: Triplett — javelin, first, 165'; discus, third, 132'10"; shot put, fifth, 44'10.5"; Babcock — high jump, tie, fourth, 5'6"; and Brobst, Pabst, Pinkerton and Kevin Burge — 4 x 800m relay, fourth, 9:44.6.
