Northern Valley wins league, Logan boys come in second

Both the Northern Valley and Logan track teams competed in the Cheyenne Conference on May 13 in Logan. The event was hosted by the Huskies.

The Northern Valley boys won their division with 139.5 points, followed by Logan, 137.5; Kensington, 120; Palco, 89; Eastern Heights, 64; and Herndon, 4.

In the girls division, Logan took first with 164 points, followed by Northern Valley, 143; Eastern Heights, 85; Kensington, 84; and Palco, 63.
