**BLUEGILL** — Norton's Jerrold Hester used nightcrawlers to snag this 9 ounce, 8 3/8" blue gill.









WIPER — Norton's Justin Waggoner snagged his 8 pound, 14 ounce, 27 1/2 inch wiper on May 8.
