City of Alma Loan Agreement

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-6
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A LOAN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ALMA, KANSAS, AND THE STATE OF KANSAS, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING A LOAN FROM THE KANSAS PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY LOAN FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING A PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY PROJECT; ESTABLISHING A DEDICATED SOURCE OF REVENUE FOR REPAYMENT OF SUCH LOAN; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING CERTAIN DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE LOAN AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Alma, Kansas, in empowered to borrow funds from the State of Kansas pursuant to K.S.A. 65-163d, et seq., for the purpose of acquisition, construction, reconstruction, improvement, equipping, rehabilitation or extension of a public water supply system; and

WHEREAS, the State of Kansas, acting through the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, has agreed to loan to the City an amount not to exceed \$615,000.00 to pay all or a portion of the costs of the City's water supply project to be repaid not later than 20 years after

completion of the project; and WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Alma, Kansas, has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Alma to acquire, construct, improve, equip, rehabilitate or extend its public water supply system.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALMA, KANSAS:
Section 1. The City of Alma, Kansas, is authorized to borrow from the State of Kansas, acting by and through the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, a sum not to exceed \$615,000.00 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, rehabilitating or extending the City's water supply system to be evidenced by a loan agreement payable not later than 20 years after completion of the project.

Section 2. The Mayor of the City and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the governing body a loan agreement documenting the amount borrowed and the terms of the transaction as specified above.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication in the official City newspaper.

ADOPTED by the governing body of the City of Alma, Kansas, this 13th day of September, 2004.
