# Airport board looks at expansion

The appointment of Jerry judge has left a vacancy in the airport board..

Norton Mayor David Corns will appoint a replacement for Mr. Hawks to the board.

At a meeting Monday night board members talked about adding a fourth person to check signing responsibilities but decided to wait until after the mayor's appointment.

The main topic at the meeting was expansion of the airport.

County Commissioner Leroy Lang suggested the airport may be a possible site for economic development projects.

Tom Brannan, Norton County Road and Bridge Supervisor, proposed the board consider a master plan for long range development.

Airport Manager Delvis Miller said there is room for four more hangars at the facility and the board decided to have Norton City  $Administrator\,Rob\,Lawson\,talk\,to$ BG Consultants, the city and county engineers, for a plan on the best way to proceed with developing the property.

After inspecting an aerial map Hawks as the new municipal court of the facility and determining who owns what property, members asked the city and county attorney Karen Griffiths to find out who owns the property called the "old dump".

In other business the board:
