# WEEKLY SERMONETTE

### "Looking For Love" — By Terry Laughlin, Living Word Church

What the world needs now is true love — true Biblical love. But just what is Biblical love? There are four types of love. The Greek language (the original language of the New Testament) uses four separate words that describe different kinds of human affection that are all translated as 'love' in English.

The Greek word 'eros' is defined as a passionate emotion. It is physical sexual attraction, infatuation or lust for power, wealth or fame. It is also indicative of the strong feelings of patriotism. It is commonly selfishly motivated and arises from

a person's own inner desires.

The Greek word storge' is an affectionate emotion. This love is a naturally born emotion and is typical of the bonds between parent and child or the attraction between a loyal citizen and a trustworthy ruler.

Both of these types of love are very unstable and are easily affected by present circumstances. They can wax cold and wane depending on the whim of the day.

Unfortunately, these are the very two types of love that seem to be most widely sought after. Certainly most forms of media and music promote these forms of 'love.' It is interesting to note that neither of these words is used for the love found in the New Testament.


