WEEKLY SERMONETTE

"Grace" — By Kirk Kasson, Congregational Church, Almena

John 1:16-17 (NIV)

From the fullness of his grace we have all received one blessing after another. For the law was given through Moses; grace

and truth came through Jesus Christ. If I really knew you, do you think I'd like you? If you answered

that question "No", ask yourself why. Why wouldn't I like you? Let me make a bold statement, which I believe to be true. I think I am capable of loving just about anybody. Now that doesn't mean I don't disagree with people, or get mad, or even feel at times

like "what you are about" is in direct opposition to "what I am about". But because I have experienced grace, both from my God, and from people within the church, I can learn to love people, even when it feels like they don't deserve my love. I enjoy getting to know people, and I bet if I got to know you, really know you, I'd like you.

God knows you better than I do, and His love is unconditional.

In our society we have learned to keep our "guard up". Many of us have been hurt by others, and are suspicious of other people's motives. We don't want to be hurt again.

How many true friends do you have? How many people know you for who you are?

If there is one person in this world who truly knows you, knows your good traits and bad, knows you the way you really are, and loves you unconditionally, then you have a glimpse of what the Bible calls GRACE.

Bruce Larson wrote the following testimony, which gives a strong sense of what I, as a pastor feel regarding this topic.

"I was a student minister at a little church up on the Hudson River. I'd go up every weekend from Princeton, where I was in seminary. Then one weekend, I found out some shocking news: a teenage girl in the congregation had left the community to live with her older brother. She was pregnant.

I said to the woman who told me, Could I go see her?, "Oh, no," she replied. "You're the last person she wants to know

what's happened." Suddenly it hit me: That's what's wrong with the church in our time. It's the place where you wear only your best clothes; you sit in Sunday school, you worship, you have a potluck together, but you don't bring your life! You leave behind all your pain, your brokenness, your hopes, even your joys.

How tragic, that even those within the church (perhaps especially within the church!) have yet to experience grace and unconditional love. I am personally convicted to try to change that fact. First to change it in my own heart, then in our church, and then as far as that influence can reach.

My ability to love other people is itself, a gift from God. I cannot take credit for it, but am learning to allow God to help me do it. There are people in your life who can show you this kind of grace. I am praying you will find them, and having received grace, you will bestow that love on
