More identified in photo of Norton 1939 football team

A photo of the 1939 Norton Community High School football team, taken from the Norton County Museum and printed in the January 4 issue of *The Norton Telegram* with a story on Norton football coaches did not have identification on some of the players. Telegram sports reporter Dick

Boyd has worked to find out who the players in the picture were. Readers were invited to submit names for those unidentified as well as those they thought were misidentified in the picture. Several readers, including Jack Ward, who helped with the story, responded.

The second player in the front row had no number but was identified as Edward "Bus" Sanderson. Mr. Ward has suggested that No. 16 in the front row is Sanderson. He was identified originally as Bob Gordon. We have also had a suggestion that he is Don Sanderson. The fifth player in the front row

was unidentified. He is wearing No. 15. No high school annual was printed in 1939-'40 but one was printed in 1941 and is on display at the Norton Public Library. No. 15 in the football team pic in the annual was Bob Gordon but it is not known if players kept the same number each season.

We had identified No. 19 in row two as Leon Stevenson but David Grabast, who lives in Portland, Ore., wrote us that the picture is of him. No. 14 in row two was identified by Mr. Ward as Bob Carney. Mr. Grabast also said that No. 32 in the back row is Forest Michaels. He was also identified as Gerald Horning. We identified No. 17 in the back

row as Gaylord Jones but Mr. Ward said that was Tom Frank. We had also identified No. 33 in the back row as Seth Antrim but Mr. Ward said it was Bob Higgins. No. 31 in the back row has been identified as Lewis Howell. The only player who has not been identified is No. 28 in the back row. Thanks to everyone who helped name the players.
