### City of Almena Proclamation

Published in The Norton Telegram on Friday, March 25, 2005. (1T)  
**PROCLAMATION**  
WHEREAS, the City of Almena, Kansas, is currently experiencing a greater than normal presence of rabid animals, and in particular, skunks, which presents an imminent danger to public safety; and  
WHEREAS, any animal not confined may be bitten by rabid animals and contract rabies.  
THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS:

That an emergency exists requiring the confinement of all animals within the City. All persons owning or harboring animals in the City of Almena are ordered to confine the animal in a sufficient enclosure from which the animal cannot escape or fasten such animal by means of a chain on the premises where the owner may reside. Any animal not confined during such time may be disposed of wherever found by the animal control officer or law enforcement officer and the owner shall be prosecuted for such violation. This proclamation shall be in effect for 90 days from this date. Any person who observes a skunk or other animal suspected to be rabid should contact the City Office or the Norton County Sheriff to arrange for the immediate destruction of the animal.
