Elmwood Park Speedway draws large field of cars

Elmwood Park Speedway in Brack. Norton, drew a field of 80 cars in four divisions Saturday with the IMCA Hobby Stock and IMCA Stock Car features giving fans more than their money's worth.

Eighteen cars took the green flag for the 15-lap IMCA Hobby Stock feature with Salina's Bill Clanton taking the early lead from his outside front row starting spot.

Remus shot past Clanton on the restart and led till the caution waved again on lap 10. Schoen's run ended when he lost a wheel on the restart, which saw Dauer, Wagenblast, Jimmy Jenkins and Gene Sneath lined up behind Remus. Wagenblast then made a pass on the outside of Remus in

Jenkins pulled alongside Wagenblast the last lap but was not able to make the pass. Remus held on for a close third over Sneath and Kelly Karnopp. Heat race winners were Wagenblast, Karnopp and Clanton. Garrett Brown topped the 10-lap B-feature.


