

Elmwood Park Speedway draws large field of cars

Elmwood Park Speedway in Norton, drew a field of 80 cars in four divisions Saturday with the IMCA Hobby Stock and IMCA Stock Car features giving fans more than their money's worth. Eighteen cars took the green flag for the 15-lap IMCA Hobby Stock feature with Salina's Bill Clanton taking the early lead from his outside front row starting spot. Clanton pulled away early, while Trevor Thornton, Jared Remus, Justin Wagner, Barry Schoen and B.J. Dauer waged a battle for second.

The first caution flag flew when Wade Wagenblast of Deshler, NE, spun, but officials deemed contact by Wagner caused the spin, so Wagenblast got his spot back and Wagner had to go to the back of the line.

Remus shot past Clanton on the restart and led till the caution waved again on lap 10. Schoen's run ended when he lost a wheel on the restart, which saw Dauer, Wagenblast, Jimmy Jenkins and Gene Sneath lined up behind Remus. Wagenblast then made a pass on the outside of Remus in turn 2 on lap 13 to take the lead.

Jenkins pulled alongside Wagenblast the last lap but was not able to make the pass. Remus held on for a close third over Sneath and Kelly Karnopp. Heat race winners were Wagenblast, Karnopp and Clanton. Garrett Brown topped the 10-lap B-feature.

The fans didn't get much time to rest as the IMCA Stock Car feature had them on their feet for most of the race as well. Selden's Jason Rogers took the lead on the opening circuit with J.R. McCreery within a car-length, trailed by Kelly Ford, Jason Davis and Nathan Glendening. The top four remained the same through lap 5 when Glendening stalled on the next lap.

On the restart, Jason Schoenberger of Russell took the point as he and Rogers ran side-by-side and nose-to-tail.

Caution flags on laps 9 and 10 kept the field bunched. Josh Hudson, winner of the March Frost Fest at Norton, had made his way to third on the restart and took command on lap 14, passing Schoenberger and Rogers.

But Hudson's chance at victory went by the wayside on lap 18 when debris from his race car caused a caution and he had to restart at the back.

With 3 laps to go, Schoenberger led the field back to green but gave way to Jeff Hunter of Henderson, Colo., who held on for an exciting finish over Schoenberger and Rogers.

Cory Struckhoff and Jason Davis rounded out the top five in the 19-car field. Struckhoff, Rogers and McCreery took the checkers in the 3 heat races.

David Murray of Oberlin won his second feature of the season at Norton with an easy win in the IMCA Modified feature, giving him 317 career wins.

Murray led by as much as half a lap most of the race. A late race caution on lap 17 bunched the field but Murray pulled away for the win. Wichita's Randy Wilson finished second, followed by Randy

Porter, Justin Basart and Bill Brack.

Following the feature, Marty Clark claimed the motor of Porter, with Porter accepting the claim.

Heat race winners included Murray, Ken Maloney, Larry Sutton and Roger Boland, while Angel Munoz of Lamar, Colo., won the B-feature.

Eleven cars took the green in the Cruiser feature which had a wild finish. Leaders Michael Hockemeier and Jim Ellis of Arapahoe, who had led from the drop of the green, were attempting to lap a slower car on the final lap when they tangled, sending them into the guardrail.

Joe and Jim Carter of Russell inherited the lead and the win. Jeff Kleen and Mark Goebel were second, followed by Bret Marietta and Brent Stallman. Hockemeier and Ellis and Wes and Chuck Eagleburger were first to the checkers in the heat races.

Racing action returns to the big 1/2-mile oval on Saturday, April 16, with the same four classes in action. Race time is 6 p.m.
