# Norton archers do well at state

The Norton County 4-H Shooting Sports archers placed in the top five individually 16 times and swept the team competition at the state shoot in Emporia on April 16.

There were 120 archers entered in the three individual classes of open, barebow and Olympic at the state competition. There were also team competitions with four shooters and one alternate per team.

Each archer shot both FITA and 3-D animal targets to get a total score.

On Friday, May 6, the Congressman will be in Phillipsburg from 3:30-4:30 p.m. at the Huck Boyd Center, 680 Park Street and in Kensington from 1:30-3 p.m. at the Kensington Community Store on Main Street
