

Northern Valley track athletes compete at state meet in Wichita

Three Northern Valley High School girls and three boys competed in Class 1A in the State Track and Field Meet on Friday and Saturday in Cessna Stadium at Wichita State University.

BOYS

Junior Joey Copper scored for the Huskies by placing sixth in the triple jump with 41 feet 1.5 inches. In the regional meet, he broke Josh Mussman's school record with a 43-3 leap.

"His jumps were pretty consistent but none were as far as his regional jump," said Coach Chuck

Fessenden.

Copper also competed in the 110-meter high hurdles. He was timed in 16.64 seconds in his preliminary heat, missing the finals by 2/10 of a second.

He placed third in the regional meet in 15.40.

"Unfortunately, Joey hit the first hurdle and his steps were off the rest of the race," said Coach Fessenden.

Junior Clarke Nelson placed tenth in the pole vault by equaling his personal record of 12 feet. Seven other vaulters also went out at 12 but finished ahead of Nelson

due to fewer misses.

Nelson placed second in the regional meet, also vaulting 12.

"Clarke vaulted well," said Coach Fessenden.

Husky senior Jesse Hilburn placed fourth in the regional in the high jump with 5-8. Competition at the state meet started at 5-10 and Hilburn did not make the opening height.

"He didn't have much warmup time and they started higher than in most of our meets," said Coach Fessenden.

"In regular season meets, they start at 5-6 and work up, which would have helped him."

Lady Husky senior Lindsey Graham bettered her gold medal winning distance of 105-10 in the regional meet with a discus throw of 109-04 but competition was enough tougher that she finished eighth at state, just out of the points since the top seven finishers medal.

"She won most of her discus competition this season," said

Coach Fessenden. "But, girls were throwing farther in other parts of the state. She threw well, however, and came close to her personal record of 111 feet."

Sophomore Kelli Cole placed sixth in her heat of the 300-meter intermediate hurdles in 50.91 and missed qualifying for the finals by 1.3 seconds. She placed fourth in regionals with a personal best time of 50.7.

"Her regional time was by far the fastest she has run all season," said Coach Fessenden. "She ran well and came close to her personal best."

Freshman Joni Hilburn tied for 10th in the pole vault at 8 feet, which tied her personal best.

She placed third in the regional with the same height.

"She vaulted pretty well," said Coach Fessenden.

"Joni barely hit the bar as she went over at 8-6 and that would have placed her. She told me that she didn't know she hit the bar because she didn't feel it."

Jennings sophomore wins state medals

Prairie Heights High School sophomore Marcus McKenna of Jennings performed well as the final athlete to compete for the Coyotes, breaking his school record in one race and equaling his personal best in another in the State Track and Field Meet in Wichita on Saturday.

Since Jennings did not have a track team in this final year of the school, McKenna competed for Hoxie High School until time for the regional meet, where he qualified for the state in Class 1A in both the 1,600-meter run and the 800-meter run. Wearing Jennings colors in the state meet, he placed fifth in the 1,600, breaking his school record of 4 minutes 43.19 seconds and sixth in the 800 in 2:05.23. He had broken the 1,600-meter school record twice earlier this year.

He missed fourth in the 1,600 by

26/100 of a second and fifth in the 800 by 1/100 of a second.

His 1,600 time was more than six seconds better than his 4:49.3 regional time and he cut more than a second off his regional 800 time of 2:06.8.

"We talked to him about running competitively since it would be the last time for a Jennings athlete to compete," said Hoxie Coach Tom Fries.

"He definitely upheld the pride of the Jennings community.

"He got boxed in several times in the 1,600 meters or could have won it. He is just a sophomore so was not as experienced as some of the other runners.

"We were really happy to have Marcus on our team this season. He works even harder than we expect. He's a great talent and did a lot for our team during the season."
