## IT'S A CARP SHOOT

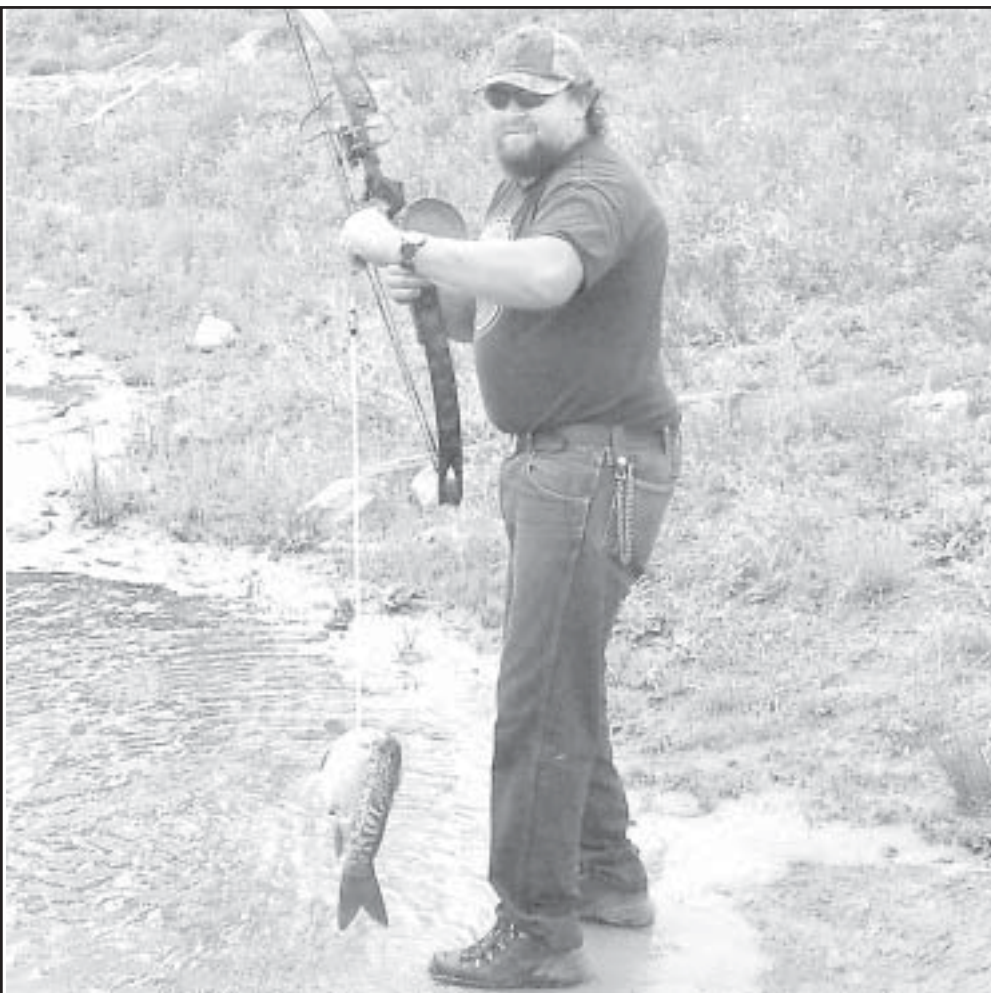
### Archery club holds 14th annual carp shoot

Shine Fischer and C.J. Culligan came in second. They had 66 fish, but also had a five minute penalty, which reduced their total to 61.

Other teams participating were Mick Kier and Brett McChesney with 28 fish, Rob Readle and Bob Readle with 27 carp, and Randy West and Pat Inman with 15 fish.
