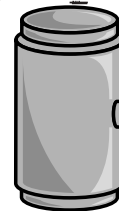

EVIDENCES OF SALVATION OBEDIENCE

There are marks of true Christianity. The characteristics of a born again Christian are seen by all. Three evidences of a man's acceptance of God's great Salvation are repentance, faith, and obedience.

Children who truly love their parents will strive to obey them. People can see which children belong to what set of parents by the way the children are responding to which adults. (1 John 5:3) Jesus said, "If anyone loves Me, he will obey my teaching." He also added, "He who does not love me will not obey My teachings. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the father who sent me." (John 14: 23 - 24)

Matthew Henry wrote, "It ought to be the great care and endeavor of everyone of us to follow the Lord fully. We must in the course of obedience do God's will and do service to His honor."

One of the evidences of man receiving God's great Salvation is obedience. If the Holy Spirit of God is not moving you to obedience to God, then you're not saved.
