


All elementary students will attend school at the Eisenhower building. However, any students living east and south of the marked line may go to the Washington building, where bus transportation will be provided to the Eisenhower school. Students should not arrive at Washington prior to 8:00 a.m. This shuttle leaves at 8:05 a.m. The same students will also be provided transportation back to the Washington building in the evening.

> The district uses an electronic bar code system called Accu-Scan for lunch tickets. Students are issued a permanent, laminated card. Initial cards are issued to each student at no cost. Cards which are lost, stolen, or defaced will cost two dollars to replace. However, any funds remaining in the account of the lost card will be transferred to the new account. Parents may purchase lunch credits in any amount.

When the amount of credit available in any account reaches a point equal to or less than two meals, a reminder is printed and given to the student.

The statement also prints the current account balance.
