

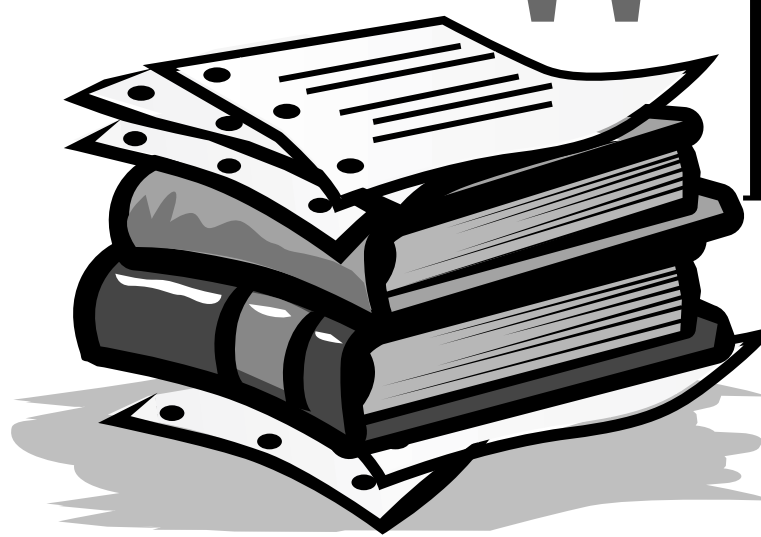

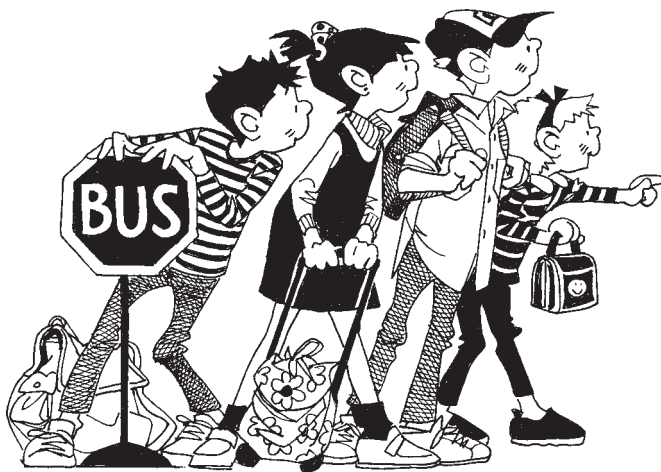

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST:

The teachers request all items be marked with the student's name
All students must have rubber sole PE shoes

KINDERGARTEN —

Crayons, no. 2 pencils with erasers, erasers, washable wide line markers, 2 boxes of Kleenex, small scissors, 2 pocket folders, 4 glue sticks, bottle of glue, 12 inch ruler with inches and metric edge, small plastic supply/pencil box, paint shirt or apron, water bottle, large towel or mat for rest time, PE shoes

FIRST AND SECOND GRADE —

2 boxes of crayons (24 regular size), 1 large box of Kleenex, 2 8 oz. bottles of Elmer's glue, 4 large glue sticks, 2 large erasers, scissors, no. 2 pencils with erasers, 2 boxes (8) magic markers (Crayola broad line), 2 school boxes, school bag, water color paint (8 colors), folders with pockets, paint shirt, water bottle, 3 spiral notebooks, PE shoes

THIRD AND FOURTH GRADE —

No. 2 pencils with erasers, 2 packages wide lined notebook paper, 3 (70 sheet) wide lined spiral notebooks, erasers, 12 inch ruler with inches and metric edge, 2 boxes of Kleenex or Puffs tissues, crayons, markers, water color paint (8 colors), colored pencils, scissors, bottle of school glue, glue stick, 4 pocket folders, erasable ink pens, paint shirt, water bottle, PE shoes

FIFTH AND SIXTH GRADE —

No. 2 pencils with erasers, black/blue ink pen, markers (broad), 2 glue sticks, 12 inch ruler with inch and metric edge, protractor, compass, scissors, 3 (70 sheet) wide lined notebooks, 2 pocket folders, strong 3 ring binder (at least 2") loose leaf notebook paper (wide lined), package of notebook dividers with label tabs, erasers, 2 boxes of Kleenex, water bottle, PE shoes

FIRST DAY OF CLASSES:

The first day of classes will be Wednesday, August 17. The school will be open at 7:45 a.m. Breakfast will be served from 7:50-8:15 a.m. Students are not to be in the school either before or after school time unless properly supervised.

POLICY OF PROOF OR IDENTITY OF STUDENTS:

Kansas law provides that whenever a child enrolls in a public school for the first time, the school is required to secure proof of identity of the child. Proof of identity is either a birth certificate for a child enrolling in kindergarten or first grade, a copy of the court order placing the child in the custody of the Social and Rehabilitation Services or a certified transcript or other similar public record of a child enrolling in Grades 2 through 12. If proof is not provided to the school within 30 days of enrollment, the school must notify the law enforcement agency which must promptly investigate the identity of the child.

STUDENT HEALTH ASSESSMENTS:

As required by current law, all students, ages 8 and under, shall submit evidence that they have undergone an appropriate health assessment prior to entering kindergarten or before enrolling in the district for the first time if they were not previously enrolled in a school in Kansas.
