ORDINANCE NO. 1549
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUNDAY SALES OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AND CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE IN THE ORIGINAL PACKAGE WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS
 BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Norton, Kansas:
 Section 1. Pursuant to 2005 Kan. Sess. Laws, Ch. 201, the sale at retail of cereal malt beverage in the original package is allowed within the city on any Sunday except Easter, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m.
 Section 2. Pursuant to 2005 Kan. Sess. Laws, Ch. 201, the sale at retail of alcoholic liquor in the original package is allowed within the city on any Sunday, except Easter, between the

hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 p.m., and on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day.
 Section 3. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.
 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication or on November 15, 2005, whichever is later, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided in 2005 Kan. Sess. Laws, Ch. 201, in which case this ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS, IN CORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION 2005
 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS:
 SECTION 1: INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the City of Lenora, Kansas that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code" Edition 2005, prepared and published by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than two copies of said

Uniform Public Offense Code will be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 328," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.
 SECTION 2: AMENDMENT. Section 1 of Ordinance 325 is hereby amended and replaced by Section 1 of this ordinance.
 SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

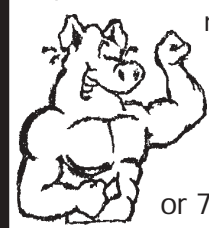
