Gerald McMaster gave a short talk.

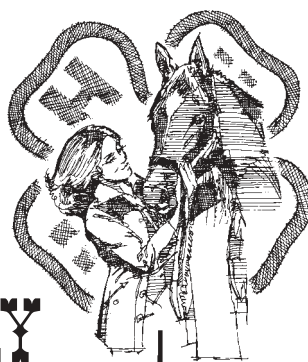
Meeting adjourned.
