WHEREAS, on this 24th day of October, 2005, at a duly constituted and regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Norton County, Kansas, and all members of the Board being present, the matter of the vacation of the road herein described, came up for final consideration and action by the Board, and having carefully considered the proposed road vacation, and having made an examination of the subject County road, finds as follows:
