PUBLIC NOTICE

City of Norton Uniform Housing Code Resolution

Published in The Norton Telegram on Tuesday, November 22, 2005. (1T)
RESOLUTION #20-2005
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NORTON TO ABATE CONDITIONS IN VIOLATION OF THE UNIFORM HOUSING CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Norton, Kansas:

Section 1. Pursuant to Article 5, Section 4 of the Code of the City of Norton, Kansas, it is hereby deemed necessary to cause the abatement of buildings or portions thereof which are determined to be substandard and/or dangerous as defined by the Uniform Housing Code, which are hereby declared to be public nuisances and shall be abated by repair, rehabilitation, demolition or removal in accordance with the procedures specified in the Uniform Housing Code. Such conditions are inimicable to the general welfare of the community and that they have a blighting influence on the adjoining properties, the neighborhood and the city, and are injurious to the health and safety of the residents of the city.

Section 2. It is hereby recognized that the property owner listed below has been given notice of the violations, has been given the notice and opportunity to be heard, and has not alleviated the conditions causing the alleged violations.

Section 3. That a public hearing was held on the matter on November 16, 2005, at 5:45 p.m., and that the property owner was properly notified and the evidence was presented at such hearing by the Public Officer.

Section 4. Following the hearing, the Governing Body, sitting as the Board of Appeals, determined that the conditions which were substandard and/or dangerous exist on the location described as belonging to Scott McNamara, 8 St. Philips Court, Worthing Little Hampton, BN176JP, West Sussex, UK 99999, within the City of Norton, Kansas, and located at 409 South Street, Norton, Kansas.

Section 5. Authorization is hereby granted to the Public Officer and the City to abate the conditions by demolition of

the substandard and/or dangerous structure which is determined to be a public nuisance. That this order of demolition shall be enforced by the Public Officer/City of Norton 30 days after the passage of this resolution. That the Public Officer/City of Norton shall cause the building described at 409 South Street, Norton, Kansas, to be vacated by posting at each entrance a notice hereof.

Section 6. That the costs incurred by the City in abating the conditions and demolishing said property shall be assessed against the property owner as provided in Chapter 15 of the Uniform Housing Code.

Section 7. This resolution shall be in force and take effect after its passage as required by law.
