



Published in The Norton Telegram on fireworks and "field burn-off" activities are prohibited unless a written burning or discharge permit is issued by one of the Norton County fire chiefs. The term "fireworks" shall be those materials defined in K.A.R. 22-6-1 The ban will be in effect until further notice.
