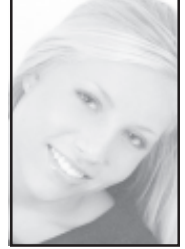
She was on the honor roll and earned a scholastic medallion.

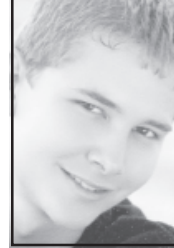
cross country and track and was on the honor roll all four years. She was awarded an "Exemplary" score on the writing portion of her SAT test.

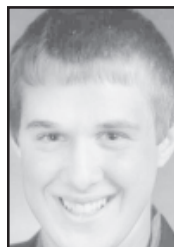
