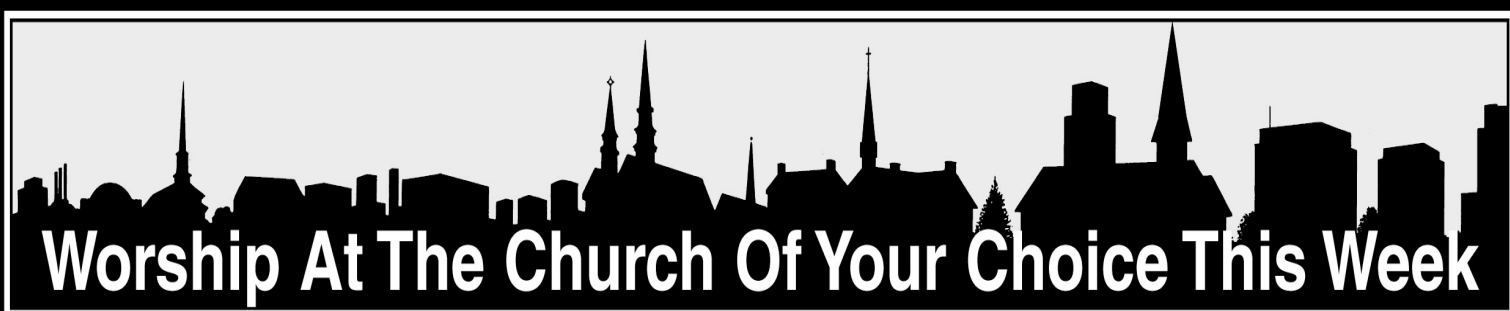
From there on down the scores were pretty well bunched up and it is more than probable that any team could capture the championship after the third and final round next Thursday.
