Jennings City Council will not meet July 6 but will instead meet July 13 in the Senior Center.

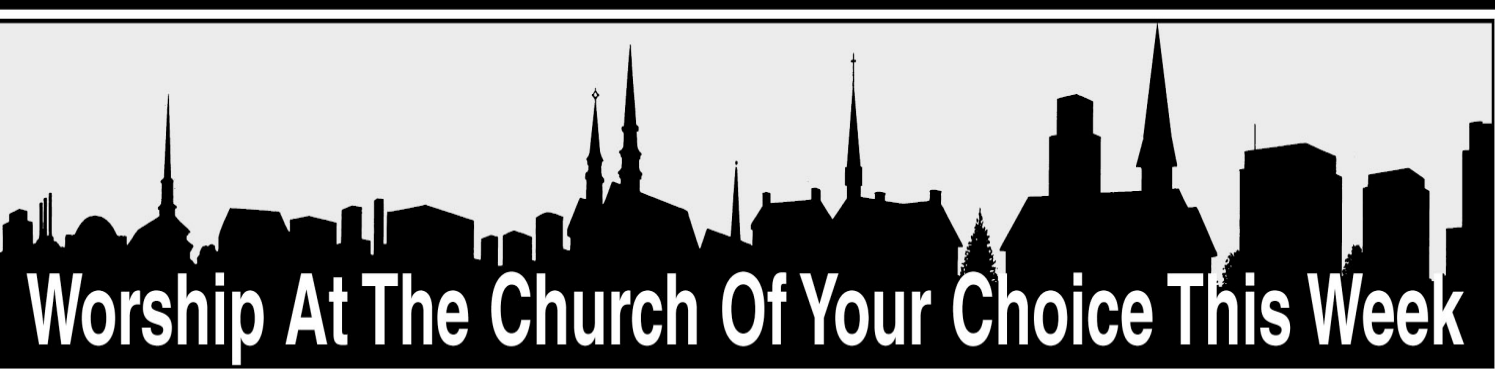
ALMENA NEWS
