Junior Jays too much for Young Guns, 42-0

The Norton Junior Jays opened their season on Sept. 9 with a win over the Goodland Young Guns, there, 42-0. The Jays dominated, rushing for 248 yards.

Jacob Brooks was leading rusher with 134 yards, Carson McKenna added 76, Jarod Bohl 29 and Treven Rossi 9. The defensive line, consisting of Javen Colip, Lucas Engel, Jordan Hartwell, Brandon Kats, John Risewick and Cassius Dole held the Young Guns to just 24 snaps. Lucas Engel was leading tackler with 3. The Jays had 4 fumble recoveries with Risewick recovering 2.

Offensive coach Cameron Archer praised the line consisting of Lane Archer, Lucas Engel (filling in for Eli Bozarth due to an injury), Jamie Harshbarger, John Renner and Dylan Sprigg, for their blocking which allowed fullback Bohn and tailback Brooks to be successful. He also cited McKenna, first year quarterback. Also coming in for praise were Christopher Fisher, wide receiver, and Ryan Bainter and Drew Ellis, ends.

Defensive coach Scott Ellis said the team played great defensively, but said they need to get more physical.

Also assisting with coaching duties are Brian McKenna and Ed Temmel.

The Northern valley physical education classes conducted the NFL punt, pass and kick competition this past week, sponsored by Pepsi. The program was for boys and girls ages 8-15. Four age divisions saw boys and girls competing separately.

Junior high punishes two Ellis teams

The Norton Junior High football team beat Ellis 46-12 in their season-opening game on Aug. 31. The game was called in the third quarter due to lightning.

Norton jumped to a 12-point lead in the first with Jeremy Sproul rushing 60 yards to score, followed by Terrell Lane snagging a 40-yard pass from Spencer Shirk. Both attempts for extra points fell short.

The Jays scored another 20 in the second to Ellis' 12. For Norton, Lane ran the ball 46 yards into the end zone. Dakota Dreher caught a pass from Shirk for the points after. Shirk rushed 1 yard for the next touchdown, this time with no extra points. For the third, Lane snagged an 80-yard pass from Shirk. The attempt for extras fell short.

Ellis' 12 came from a 75-yard kick-off return from Jacob Kinderknecht and a 3-yard pass from Kinderknecht to Jared Herl.

In the third, Sproul made a 95-yard punt return to score. Lane ran in the extra points. Troy Bainter made the last touchdown of the game on a 6-yard run. The attempt for points after failed, leaving the score 46-12 when the game was called.

Sproul led rushing for the Jays with 79 yards on 5 carries. He was followed by Lane, 73 on 6; Bainter, 21 on 8; and Shirk, 10 on 5. Shirk completed 4 of 7 passes for 138 yards. Receiving were Lane, 2 for 120 yards, and Dreher, 2 for 18 yards. Dreher led tackles with 6 solos and 4 assists, followed by Sproul, 4 solos; Lane, 2 solos, 2 assists; Landon Keiswetter, 1 solo, 3 assists; and Kaid McKenna, 1 solo, 1 assist.

Junior Varsity
The Norton junior varsity team beat Ellis 30-0. The Jays scored 16 in the first with Tye Nickell rushing 10 yards for the first touchdown. Jordan Wahlmeier ran in the

extra points. Trey Millan brought in six more points on a 4-yard run with Nickell running in the points after.

In the second quarter, Wahlmeier rushed 42 yards to score. Dillon McConney caught a pass from Wahlmeier for the extra points. Justin Waggoner scored for the Jays on a 55-yard pass from Wahlmeier, giving the team its 30 points.

Wahlmeier led rushing with 114 yards on 6 carries, followed by Nickell, 87 on 11; Robert Blecha, 33 on 4; Millan, 33 on 6; Taylor Meder, 23 on 9.

Wahlmeier completed 2 of 4 passes for 58 yards. Receiving were Waggoner, 1 for 55 yards, and McConney, 1 for 3 yards.
