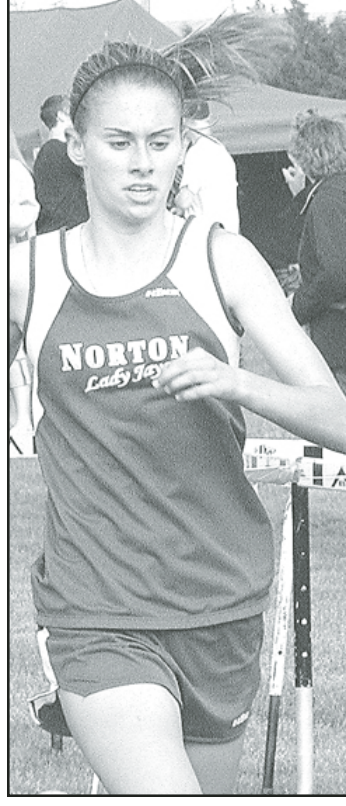

The Norton Community High School varsity golf team competed in the TMP Invitational Tournament at the Smoky Hill Country Club in Hays on Monday. Norton placed 11th out of 13 competing teams. Hays High won the championship with a 326, followed by Phillipsburg, 341; Goodland, 353; Thomas More Prep, 355; Colby, 357; Trego, 360; Russell, 367; Oberlin, 372; Scott City, 382; Larned, 390; Norton, 391; Stockton, 409; Ellis, 416.

Scoring for Norton were: Preston Herman, 45/46-91; Michael Ward, 49/50-99; J.D. Gall, 52/47-99; Kyle Edgett, 51/51-102.

Also playing for the Blue Jays and their scores were: Pat Burton, 51/51-102 and Marcus Herman, 54/57-111.

"We did not play as well today as we had in previous tournaments," said Norton head coach David Stover.

"The Smoky Hill course is one of the tougher setups we see and today, at least in our case, the course won. We did not handle the thick rough very well and our short game was not as sharp as it needed to be.

"Today should be a good preparation for our late season stretch beginning with the Colby Invitational on Thursday."

The Norton Community High School junior varsity golf team placed sixth in four-man competition in the Trego Invitational Varsity Golf Tournament on Thursday, April 26.

Trego won four-man play with a 330, followed by Ellis, 382; Osborne, 396; Plainville, 430; Ness City, 436; Norton, 458; Wheatland/Grinnell, 458.

Norton did not enter a two-man team. Results were: Wheatland/Grinnell, 170; Plainville, 174; Osborne, 181; Hill City, 185; Ness City, 187; Oakley, 214; Trego, 218; Ellis, 225.

Six-man team results were: Trego, 524; Osborne, 563; Wheatland/Grinnell, 581; Plainville, 604; Ellis, 607; Ness City, 623.

Norton's low scorer was Kyle Edgett with a 51/52-103, followed by Logan Kelly, 55/58-113; Lacy Keilig, 62/53-115; Andrew Black, 65/62-127; Kyle Mindrup, 65/67-132.

"We gained valuable varsity experience with our junior varsity squad today," said Norton head coach David Stover. "We took advantage of ideal weather conditions to see improvement in each player's performance, primarily that of Kyle Edgett and especially the back nine of Lacy Keilig. Hopefully, the momentum gained today will carry over into next week's season-ending junior varsity tournaments at Norton and Trego."

The Norton junior varsity competed on Tuesday in the Norton Junior Varsity Invitational, scheduled to begin at 3 p.m. on the PDRA course south of Norton.

The Blue Jay junior varsity also competed in the Trego Junior Varsity Tournament on Thursday in WaKeeney, beginning at 9 a.m.

At Smith Center

Norton Community High School junior varsity golfers competed in the Smith Center Junior Varsity Invitational Tournament on Tuesday, April 24.

No team results were kept but three Blue Jay golfers were medalists.

Grand McClymont was No. 8 medalist with a 53. Connor Pfannstiel and Kyle Mindrup each shot 54s and tied for No. 11 medalists.

Also playing for the Blue Jays and their scores were: Ashley Colip, 57; Justin Chandler, 63; Jacob VanSkike, 67. "I was pleased with the way we played today," said Norton head

coach David Stover. "All our golfers showed signs of improvement and were able to handle windy conditions to play some of our best golf of the season.

"We are very pleased with the medals earned by Grant, Connor and Kyle but we have seen improvement from all six of these golfers since the beginning of this hectic week."
