Steve Towery, McCook, Neb., visited Jean and Donna Leuszler Saturday.

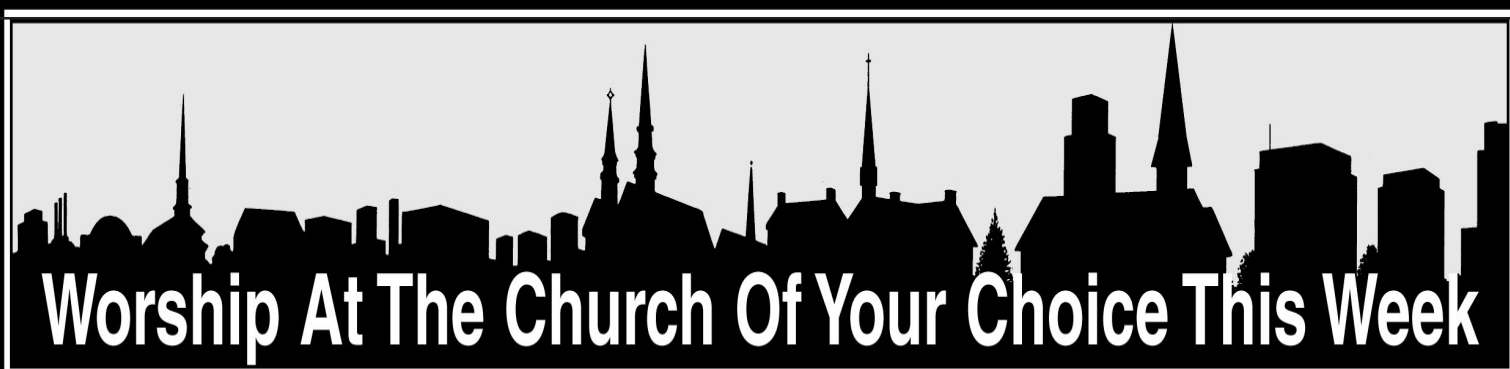
