ORDINANCE NO. 1563 AN ORDINANCE REGULATING **PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE** CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS;

INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE **CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES.**' **EDITION OF 2007, AND REPEALING** ORDINANCE #1556.

IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS

Section 1. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Norton, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2007, Darla R. Ellis, City Clerk

Published in The Norton Telegram on prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1563", and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. REPEAL. Ordinance number 1556 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
