Isaiah 40:28-31 says, "Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. What determines your ability to enjoy God's grace is your faith in the truths of what Christ spoke, "**Surely I Am With You Always**"
