## Cross Roads

### WALKING IN THE CONFIDENCE OF GOD PART 1

"Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, 'Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.' So we say with confidence, 'The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?'" (Hebrews 13:5-6)

Those who walk in the confidence of God have the marks of contentment: They live a life without covetousness, they are satisfied with what they have, and they experience the constant companionship and care of Almighty God.
