The Class 1A Regional Tournament at Logan High School Tuesday brought the Northern Valley volleyball season to an end.

The Lady Huskies lost to Logan, the eventual second place finisher, 24-26, 14-25, in the tourney.

"We traveled to Logan for the regional with high hopes of going on to sub state. We played Logan for the privilege of going and we started off well. Very well for that matter, as we played with intensity and focus covering the court and making the Trojans play defense against our attack game," coach Chuck Zimmerman said.

"We were ahead 13-7 at the end of the first rotation and seemed to be in control. We were even ahead 24-18 at the end of our second rotation, but then all of a sudden, as this sport is infamous for, the tide turned and we did not score another point while Logan served and played its way to a 24-26 victory," he said.

"Now is the time for our younger players to start thinking and even preparing for our next and future seasons. They can do much to continue to improve on the skills they obtained this season," he added.

"The players and coaches want to thank the fans who came to Logan for their support as it meant a great deal to the team to see a fourth of the gym rooting for us. We especially want to thank those who followed us 'on the road' all

year long. We greatly appreciate your loyalty and hope that you enjoyed us when we were at our best," the coach said.
