POSITION: The Kansas Department of Corrections is taking applications for two Reentry Specialists to deliver risk reduction and reentry (R3) services at Norton Correctional Facility, a medium custody facility with a minimum satellite unit in Stockton. These positions will work with the Classification Administrator, unit team, parole, release planning staff, and other R3 staff at NCF and statewide, to develop and implement risk reduction and reentry case management, classes, and resources, to address the risk reduction and reentry needs of high risk/need offenders housed at NCF, particularly those within a year of release. This position is part of the implementation of the Kansas Offender Risk Reduction and Reentry Plan (KOR3P), see <http://www.dc.state.ks.us/reentry/goals-of-kor3p>.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: A bachelor's degree with major coursework in criminal justice, the social sciences or the behavioral sciences, and one year of experience working with offenders in corrections, parole, or law enforcement. Additional experience may be substituted for the required education as determined relevant by the agency.
