Family Members, Friends, Church Family, the Body of Christ and to all who would inquire about the present health crisis of Bonnie Laughlin:

Bonnie Laughlin was diagnosed with brain cancer about five years ago. By the grace of God, working through medical treatment, Bonnie has lived well past the life expectancy of someone diagnosed with a level 2 (mostly), level 3 (slightly) astrocytoma brain cancer. Over the last year, particularly over the past several months, Bonnie's health has declined somewhat. On Tuesday, January 29, it was confirmed by Dr. Gaspar that her brain cancer is now recurrent. A multi-disciplinary team of oncologists have informed us that Bonnie should start chemotherapy treatments as soon as possible.
