## Agency to expand candidates pool

The Farm Service Agency is looking to expand the pool of candidates that will run for three-year terms on the farmer elected County Office committee. "We are looking for the broadest possible participation from anyone within the farming community," Vesta Hobbs County Executive Director of the Norton County Farm Service Agency said. "There is a lot of skill and experience out there that we have not tapped into in the past and that we really could use." The FSA County Committee is the most direct link between USDA farm programs and local producers. The County Committee system helps shape nation wide programs into programs that work

at the local level by making decisions on issues like commodity price support loans and payments for some crops. Farm Service Agency committees also make eligibility determinations for farm loans and conservation programs, as well as disaster assistance. "To make the system work, it must represent all of the different parts of local agriculture," Ms. Hobbs said. "This means the business side of the operation of the small farmer, people in specialty crops, truck farmers, new farmers, women and minority farmers, all people with unique and valuable insights and perspective to the business. We need their help and experience." The County Committee election will be held from Nov. 3 through

Dec. 1, The nomination petitions are due by Aug. 1. The people elected to the Committee will become part of the national network of farmers and ranchers who have a unique opportunity to help the future of all local producers. It is described as government at its best, local in nature, focused here at home, and bringing the resources and expertise of the USDA together with the Farm Service Agency's customers in rural America.
