In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the voters of NORTON COUNTY, Kansas may register to vote at the following places during regular office hours: Norton City Office, Alma City Office, Lenora City Office and the Norton County Clerk's Office.

At 5:00 p.m. on the 21st day of July, 2008 the books for registration of voters will close and will remain closed until the 6th day of August, 2008.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Registration closes 14 days prior to every election.

When a registered voter changes residence from one precinct to another precinct, such voter must re-register in order to be eligible to vote. Any person may apply in person, by telephone, or by mail to the county election officer to be registered. Application forms shall be provided by the county election officer upon request by the applicant. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.

When a registered voter fails to vote in two consecutive general elections, such voter's name may be removed from the registration books and party affiliation lists. Such voter must re-register in order to be eligible to vote.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LICENSING AND INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS OF TAXICAB SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS, as follows:

Section 1: DEFINITIONS. The following words, terms and phrases, as used in this article shall have the following meaning:

- a. *Owner* or operator means any person engaged in the business of operating a taxicab in the city.
- b. *Taxicab* means any automobile or similar vehicle having a regular seating capacity, including the driver, of not more than nine adult persons, engaged in carrying passengers for hire other than along a fixed route.

Section 2: PERMIT REQUIRED. No person shall operate or drive a taxicab, or permit the operation of any taxicab owned by such person, upon any of the streets, avenues, alleys or public places within the city without first procuring a permit from the City of Norton. No permit to operate a taxicab in the City shall be issued to any person until they have complied with all the provisions of this article.

Section 3: APPLICATION AND PERMIT PERIOD. An Application for a permit required by this article shall be made on a form to be furnished by the city clerk. The fee is accompany the request for a permit shall be \$25.00. A permit shall be for a period of 12 months and may be revoked or suspended upon ten days' notice in writing served upon the holder thereof for a violation of this article. Any holder of a permit under this article automatically forfeits such permit, and such permit shall become void and of no effect, if such permit holder operates or permits the operation of any taxicab in the city without such taxicab being covered at the time by a liability insurance policy as provided in this article. Such permits are not assignable or transferrable.

Section 4: LIABILITY INSURANCE. It shall be unlawful for any person, either as owner, operator, driver or lessee, to operate or drive, or permit to be operated or driven, a taxicab in the city unless such taxicab is covered by a public liability insurance policy, complying with the terms of this article. The insurance policy required by this section shall be issued by a solvent, incorporate insurance company authorized to underwrite automobile liability insurance in this state. The insurance policy required by this division shall provide for a liability coverage of not less than fifty thousand dollars for the injury to, or death of, one person in any one accident and, subject to the limit for one person, to a limit of not less than one hundred thousand dollars because of injury to, or death of, two or more persons in any one accident, and to a limit of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars for property damages in any one accident, or a one hundred thousand dollars combined single limit.

Section 5: SIGNAGE. All taxicabs shall have the words "taxi" or "taxicab" on at least one door on each side of the taxicab in letters not less than four inches in height and of corresponding width, in paint of a different color from that of the remainder of the door, so as to easily read.

Section 6: OPERATORS. It shall be unlawful for any person to act as the driver of a taxicab in the City without first having secured a driver's license and having in his or her possession at all times, a valid state of Kansas, Class C drivers license. It shall also be the responsibility of the holder of a taxicab permit to assure that no driver is allowed to operate a vehicle, in service, without holding and displaying a valid taxicab driver's license as specified in this Section. All operators shall furnish a copy of their driver's license as part of the application permit. The document or evidence documenting the taxicab permit shall be posted in each vehicle operated as a taxi.

Section 7: PENALTY. The violation of any provision of this Chapter and Article shall be deemed a misdemeanor. Any person, firm, association, partnership or corporation convicted thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 or greater than \$1000 per offense.

Section 8: This ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the official city newspaper.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR A CITY STREET; OPENING AN OFFICIAL CITY STREET; ESTABLISHING A STREET DESCRIPTION AND MINIMUM WIDTHS; PROVIDING FOR THE DEDICATION OF THE PROPOSED STREET FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE AND ESTABLISHING A STREET NAME WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the governing body of the City of Norton, Kansas deems it necessary and expedient to open a street within the City of Norton, Kansas and dedicate said street for a public purpose. That the legal description of said land, with a required width of 40 feet, which will hereinafter be dedicated as a public street is:

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Lot 1, Block 2, Timbercreek Addition to the City of Norton, Kansas, thence S 90° 00'00" W 275.66 Feet to a point; thence along a curve to the left with a radius of 140.00 feet, chord bearing of S 0° 00'00" W, chord distance of 280.00 feet and are length of 439.82 feet to a point; thence S 90° 00'00" E 271.46 feet to a point; thence N 00° 51'27" E 40.00 feet to a point; thence S 90° 00'00" W 272.06 feet to a point; thence along a curve to the right with a radius of 100.00 feet, chord bearing of N 0° 00'00" E, chord distance of 200.00 feet and are length of 314.16 feet to a point; thence N 90° 00'00"E 275.06 feet to a point; thence N 00° 51'27" E 40.00 feet to the point of beginning, all in Norton, Norton County, Kansas.

SECTION TWO: That in accordance with K.S.A. 14-423, the City of Norton accepts the tract of land described above as public right-of-way for street and right-of-way purposes. That the land hereinbefore described shall hereafter be dedicated as a city street and that no building or other development shall be built upon or within the legal description so shown.

SECTION THREE: That upon passage of this ordinance as provided by law, this right-of-way shall be opened as a city street, hereinafter which shall be known as Timbercreek Drive.

SECTION FOUR: That upon the effective date of this ordinance, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Norton County Clerk and the Norton County Register of Deeds.
