## **Blessings**

Deuteronomy 28:1-2 says, "If you fully obey the LORD your God and carefully follow all His commands I give you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations on earth. All these blessings will come upon you and accompany you if you obey the LORD your God."

The Book of Deuteronomy contains promises and the effectiveness of a nation is determined by God's blessings upon a nation's armed forces, economic systems and families. (Deuteronomy 28)

The Bible says, "[Jehoshaphat] did what was right in the eyes of the Lord." (1 Kings 22:34; 2 Chronicles 20:32) "In the third year of his reign he sent... five officials out "to teach in the towns of Judah. With them were..." nine Levites and "the priest Elishama and Jehoram. They taught throughout Judah, taking with them the Book of the Law of the Lord; they went around to all the towns of Judah and taught the people." (2 Chronicles 17:7-9) "The fear of the Lord fell on all the kingdoms of the lands surrounding Judah, so that they did not make war with Jehoshaphat... Jehoshaphat became more and more powerful; he built forts and store cities in Judah and had large supplies in the towns of Judah." (2 Chronicles 17:10,12)

The United States of America enjoys the same blessings that God's people did because of the Biblical conviction of her Founding Fathers. She has known prosperity, many victories in war, being a leading nation, a nation whom other nations fear as well as being used of God to evangelize many parts of the world.
