A nation that is vigilant has Christians who take to heart 1 Timothy 2:1-2, "I urge, then, first of all, request, prayers, intersession thanksgiving be made for everyone - for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and The Apostle Paul used the word holiness." 
