

ORDINANCE NO. 1581 AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS BY ESTABLISHING A THREE-WAY STOP INTERSECTION AT **EAST WASHINGTON AND SOUTH** ARCHER AND ALTERING

THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON SOUTH ARCHER STREET AND **PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES** BE IT ORDAINED BY THE **GOVERNING BODY** 

of the City of Norton, Kansas:

Section I. STOP INTERSECTION. In accordance with the provisions of Section 59 of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, the following intersection is hereby designated as a three-way stop intersection and when a sign is erected at the entrance as stated, the drivers of vehicles shall stop, as provided by said Section 59, before entering the intersection:

The intersection of East Washington and South Archer Street. stopping the east and west bound traffic on East Washington Street and the south bound traffic on

Archer Street, all in the City of Norton, Kansas

Section 2. SPEED LIMITATION. In accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1560 and K.S.A. 8-2002, the maximum speed limit on South Archer Street from the intersection of the streets of South Archer and East Washington to the entrance to Elmwood Park, shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour, which is a reasonable and safe maximum speed considering the intersection and the curve

Section 3. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fines for violation of the stop intersection provisions and speed limitations of this ordinance are those prescribed for the Standard Traffic Ordinance of Norton.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper, and the erection of the stop signs. PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY of the City of
