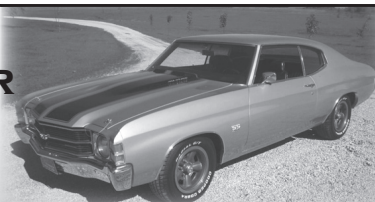
Local Man Prevails In Scuffle With Hoodlums
