**ORDINANCE NO. 1582
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF THE
NORTON CITY CODE RELATING TO MUNICIPAL COURT FEES**
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 9-107 of the Code of the City of Norton, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-107. HOME DETENTION FEE. In all cases filed in the Municipal Court of Norton, Kansas, where monitored home detention, house arrest or home incarceration is required by the municipal court judge, there shall be assessed a daily detention and monitoring fee of \$15.00 per day. That the defendant shall pay said charge in advance of any home detention, house arrest or home incarceration.

Section 2. That any ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby amended.

Section 3. This ordinance becomes effective upon publication in the official city newspaper.
