Championship victory in Holiday Classic

Coach Bill Johnson's Norton Community High School wrestling team completed the 2008 year with an impressive championship victory in the tough Holiday Classic Wrestling Tournament on Saturday in Goodland.

Competing in the dual tournament, in addition to Norton and Goodland, were teams from Scott City, Dodge City, Wichita County, Burlington, Hugoton, Hoxie, Garden City, Buhler, Pratt and Ulysses.

Teams battled it out in three pools to determine matchups for final placing. Norton was in a pool with Burlington, Hugoton and Hoxie. The Blue Jays set the stage for the finals by powering to a 3-0 record in their pool. They defeated Hoxie 66-9, Hugoton 47-22 and Burlington 50-27.

Goodland and Garden City won the other pools so they were matched up in duals with Norton to decide the championship. Norton took on an outstanding Goodland team first and defeated the Cowboys 40-24, then had to come from behind to edge an excellentGardenCitysquad33-31 to win the team championship!

Final team placings were: Norton, Goodland, Garden City, Scott City, Burlington, Ulysses, Dodge City, Hugoton, Pratt, Buhler, Hoxie, Wichita County.

"I'm excited about our overall performance," said coach Johnson. "We overcame some adversity, especially in the Garden City dual. We had to alter our lineup a little but our guys responded and were able to get a victory.

"After the 140 pound match, which is halfway through the match, we were down 23-9. Then we won 5 of the last 7 matches to win the dual and the championship. It all came down to the heavyweight match. We moved Jordan Bebb up to heavyweight and he pinned his opponent in 41 seconds to secure the victory!

"We also wrestled extremely well in our win over Goodland.

"This is a tough tournament. We haven't won it since 2004. We see a lot of teams in this tournament that we don't get to wrestle during the season.

"I was so proud of our wrestlers stepping up individually when needed at various weights to help out the team. That brings out the team aspect of the sport.

"The fact that we have a very young team this year makes this win even more special."

For his outstanding performance in the tournament, coach Johnson awarded the "Wrestler of the Week" award to sophomore \145 pound wrestler Kaid McKenna. "Kaid had an outstanding tournament," said coach Johnson. "He pinned four opponents and defeated another by a technical fall. Kaid gave up just four points in the entire tournament."

Sophomore Billy Broeckelman, 119 pound wrestler for the Blue Jays, also received a special award for the fastest fall of the tournament! Billy pinned an opponent in just 11 seconds!

The vote by team coaches for the "Outstanding Wrestler" of the tournament ended in a tie between Joey Dozier, Garden City, 140 and Keegan Smith, Goodland,

Norton compiled an outstanding 45-22 won-loss record and had a pin ratio of 21-8.
