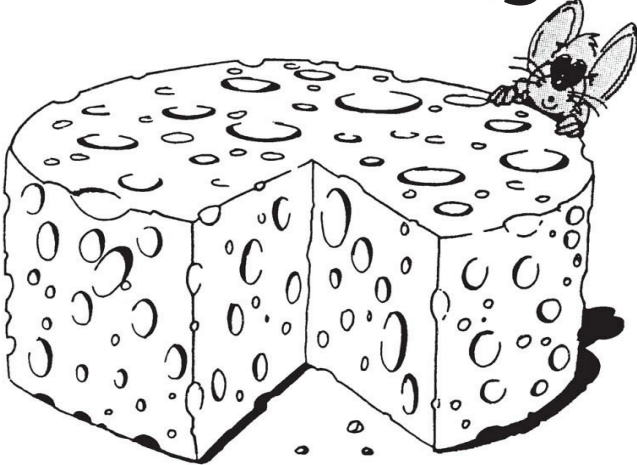

A Necessity in Corporate Worship

At least four times in the New Testament Christians are told to "Greet one Another." The Apostle Paul proclaims a powerful truth about his work with the Lord that the Body of Christ should take note of. 2 Corinthians 5:20 says, "We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making His appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf..." All Christians are "Commissioned" to the work of the gospel of Christ in some way. William Barclay writes, "Here is the Christian's proud privilege and almost terrifying responsibility." The honor of Christ and His church are in the hands of Christians and how they greet those coming into their corporate services determines the impression visitors will have on the rest of the service. By their very words and actions they make mankind think more or less of the Body of Christ and their corporate worship services.

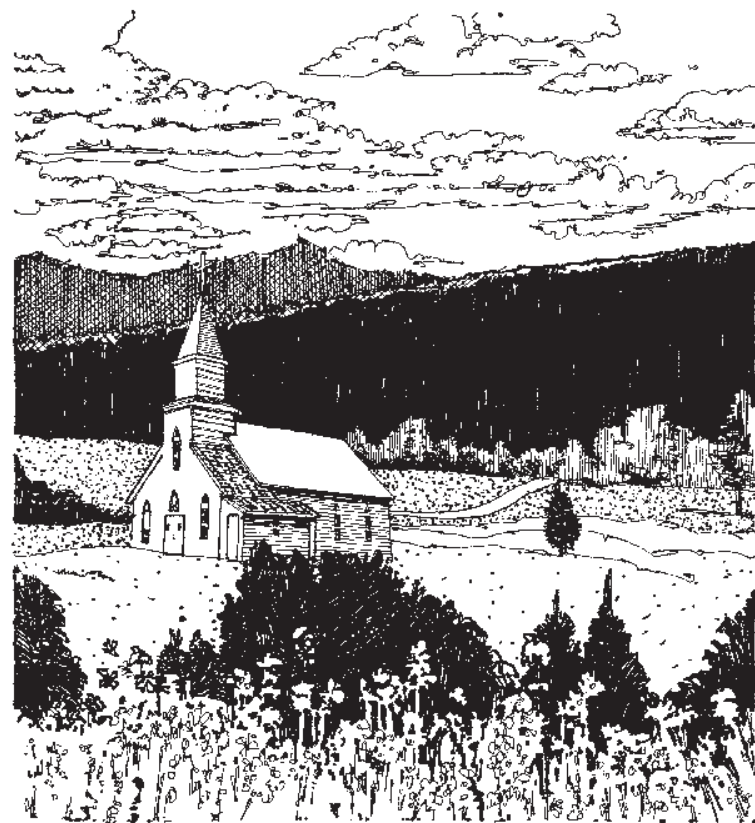
