



William Barclay writes, "Here is the Christian's proud privilege and almost terrifying responsibility." The honor of Christ and His church are in the hands of Christians and how they greet those coming into their corporate services determines the impression visitors will have on the rest of the service. By their very words and actions they make mankind think more or less of the Body of Christ and their corporate worship services.


