NOTICE OF INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLANNING MEETING TO ALL PERSONS CONCERNED:

You are hereby notified that Sunflower Electric Power Corporation (Sunflower) seeks input from the public in preparing an Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) to be submitted to Western Area Power Administration (Western) pursuant to Federal Register Vol. 65, No. 62, dated March 30, 2000/Rules and Regulations part 905-Energy Planning and Management Program.

The purposes of the IRP are to meet the objectives of the Energy Planning and Management Program (EPAMP) of Section 114 of the Energy Policy Act of 1992 (EPAAct) and to extend the long-term firm power resource commitments of Western while supporting customer integrated resource planning; demand-side management (DSM), including energy efficiency, conservation, and load management; and the use of renewable energy.

You are invited to attend a meeting to be held at the Hadley Center, James Room, 204 West 8th Street, Hays, Kansas, on April 13, 2009, from 9:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain public input into Sunflower's planning process for new energy resources in order for Sunflower to provide adequate and reliable services to its Members, and its Members' electric consumers. Topics include, but not by limitation, new generating capacity, power purchases, energy conservation and efficiency, cogeneration, heating and cooling applications and renewable resources. In addition, you may submit written comments to Sunflower at the address stated below. All written comments must be received no later than April 30, 2009.

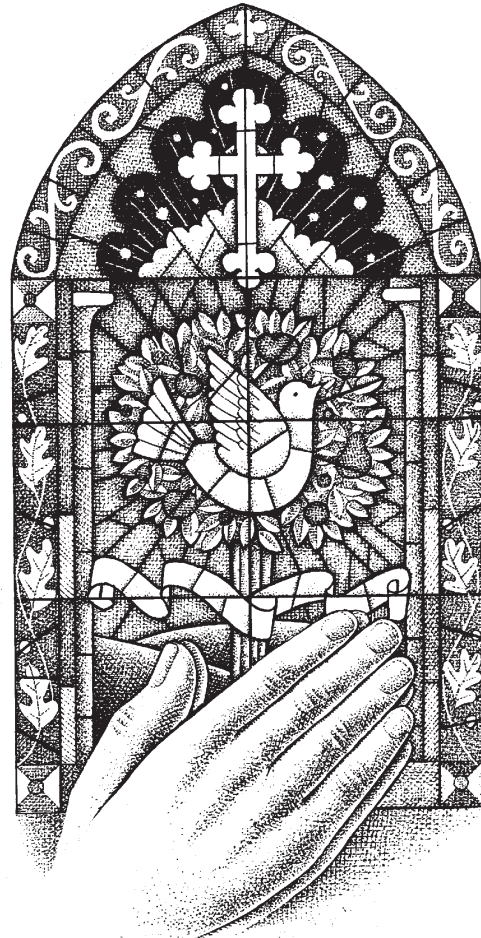
