Blue Jay golfers settle for fifth at tourney

The Norton Community High School golf team placed fifth in the Mel Schremmer Invitational golf tournament on Monday, May 11 in Phillipsburg.

Phillipsburg won the six-man championship by carding a 501, followed by Trego Community, 522; Thomas More Prep-Marian of Hays, 529; Plainville, 535; Norton, 544; Smith Center, 546; Osborne, 557; Phillipsburg JV, 648.

The Blue Jays' two-man team of juniors J.D. Gall and Marcus Herman placed fifth and Norton's four-man team of junior Connor Pfannenstiel, senior Logan Kelly, sophomore Cole Archer and senior Kyle Mindrup also placed fifth.

Phillipsburg won the two-man competition with a 152, followed by Plainville, 164; Smith Center, 164; Thomas More Prep, 165; Norton, 178; Osborne, 184; Trego, 186; Stockton, 196; Ellis, 209; Phillipsburg JV, 255.

Trego was the four-man champion with a 336, followed by Phillipsburg, 349; Oberlin, 350; Thomas More Prep, 364; Norton, 366; Plainville, 371; Osborne, 373; Smith Center, 382; Phillipsburg JV, 393; Stockton, 428; Russell, 455.

Gall shot a 42/42-84 and Herman carded a 46/48-94.

On Norton's four-man team, Pfannenstiel shot a 43/43-86, followed by Kelly, 43/44-87; Archer, 48/48-96 and Mindrup, 49/48-97.

Gall was twelfth medalist and Pfannenstiel was fifteenth medalist.

his first individual medal at the varsity level.

"We are improving but need consistency from all golfers to

put together a solid four-man team score. Hopefully, the momentum we started today will continue into post-season."
